Thank you for your interest in our products. Gail Redman Woodturning has been established in San Francisco since 1977. Our company has consistently provided high quality turnings to homeowners, contractors, and furniture makers in the Bay Area. These products are now available everywhere by mail order.

All of our turnings, no matter how large or small the order, are done by hand. Turning by hand, especially of softwoods, produces a much crisper, cleaner product than automatic turning. We will produce any turning design from an original sample, line drawing, photograph, or another catalogue. Standard dimensions of any design in our catalogue can be altered to suit your needs.

The wood species that is typically used is Canadian western red cedar. It is clear, all-heart, and dry. It has comparable decay and pest resistance to first-growth redwood at lower cost. Turnings are also available in redwood, fir, poplar, oak, and other hardwoods.

Orders may be placed by phone, fax, or directly at the shop at 77 - 14th Street in San Francisco. Please call ahead if coming to the shop. A deposit will be required for all orders. Shipping is available by UPS or common carrier in plywood boxes.

INSTALLATION SUGGESTIONS:

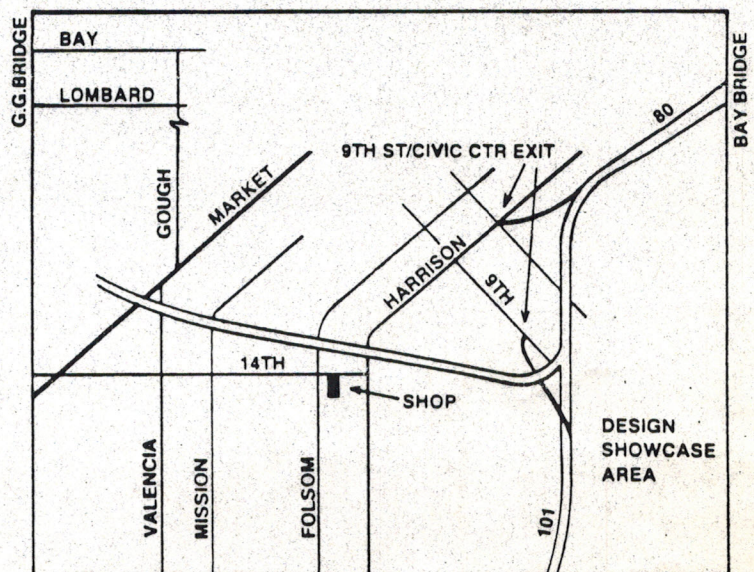
All turned products should be stored in a cool, dry, well-ventilated location prior to installation. If they are being installed outdoors, they should never be allowed to sit in the sun before they are primed. Exterior turnings should be primed on all sides before installation, including the ends after they have been cut to fit. It is suggested that the first coat of primer be a stain resistant primer to lock in tannins if the turnings are of redwood or cedar. Finials or newel tops should be primed two or more times on the exposed end grain to protect against checking. Pilot holes should be drilled before nailing or screwing the turnings into place to protect against splitting.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOP:

From the **East Bay** take 80W to the 9th St/Civic Center Exit. Follow Harrison St to 14th St and turn right.

From the **South Bay** take 101N to the 9th St/Civic Center Exit. Go 1 blk on 9th to Harrison and turn left. Follow Harrison to 14th St and turn right.

From **Marin** take 101S to Gough St and turn right. Follow Gough to Market St and turn right. Immediately turn left to Valencia St. Go 3 blks to 14th St and turn left.

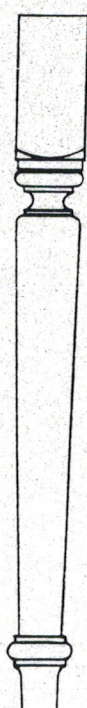

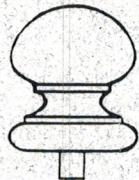

CABINET KNOBS (left)

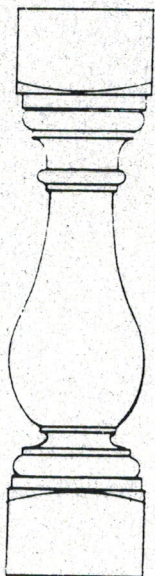

4 X 4 SPINDLES (below)

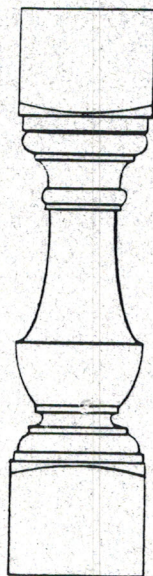

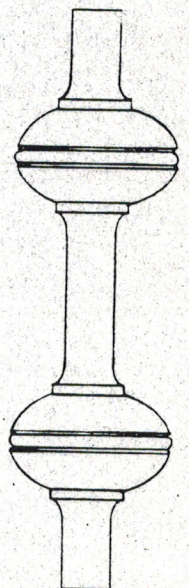
